Are you 18+ years old? Did you leave high school before completing the courses you needed to get your diploma? Are you happy with your life? How do you feel since you have dropped out of high school?

Many high school dropouts come to realize that getting a diploma is the key to moving ahead in life. The problem is most people figure it's too late to do anything about it. Well, it's not!

GATEWAY – AGES 18-22

This program is for adults between the ages of 18 and 22. Students must meet the current graduation requirements from the time of entry in 9th grade (i.e. earn required number of credits; pass OGT/proficiency, etc.). Students will receive a high school diploma from their former home school. This student must be withdrawn from high school for a minimum of one year.

GATEWAY – 22+ HSD

The 22+ Adult High School Diploma Program helps adults earn a high school diploma. The program is free to adults who are over 22 years old, living in Ohio and do not have a diploma or a GED. Students must meet the graduation requirements from the time of entry in 9th grade (i.e. earn required number of credits; pass OGT/proficiency, etc.). This student will receive a high school diploma from the school district in which he/she lives.

ADULT DIPLOMA PROGRAM

The Adult Diploma Program provides job training and a new pathway for adults, ages 22 or older, to earn a high school diploma AND industry credentials aligned to one of Ohio's in-demand jobs. This student will earn a state issued high school diploma.

What makes this program different is the delivery of instruction to adults. Instead of measuring academic achievement through credits earned, the focus is on a competency-based approach.
