The health and safety of our staff and students will also continue to be a top priority and VSCTC will implement recommended safety protocols to the highest degree possible and will work with our local health departments to promote safety in all school facilities.

Guiding Principles:

- Everyone must assume personal responsibility to abide by the implementation of safety protocols to the highest degree possible.
- VSCTC will work closely with our local health departments to assist in creating a healthy and safe environment on our campuses.
- VSCTC will take steps to ensure quality student learning will continue despite potential disruption due to the on-going pandemic.
- VSCTC recognizes the need for consistency amongst all schools and areas of operations while also understanding that individual differences of lab/classroom size, population of labs, and building operations may lead to varying schedules and protocols amongst the different labs on campus.
- VSCTC will be transparent with all our stakeholders and that some level of risk will always be present when students and staff occupy our facilities.
- School plans will continually be re-evaluated and modifications will be made if needed to ensure and safe and healthy environment is maintained while a quality education continues to be delivered.

Daily Operational/Safety Protocols

- Learning Schedules
 - All district buildings will be operating on a normal 5 day a week schedule.
 - Remote Learning days may be incorporated into the schedule throughout the school year as part of the VSCTC blended learning initiative. Advanced notice will be provided.
- Face coverings
 - There are currently no state orders mandating face coverings in Ohio.
 - The ODH recommends that masks be worn indoors, in crowded settings and where physical distancing cannot be maintained.
 - Staff, Students, and Visitors will have the option to choose whether or not to wear face coverings inside the buildings.

- When staff/students are traveling on any district owned vehicles, ie...van or bus, a face covering must be worn.

- Daily temperature/symptom checks
 - Temperature/Symptom checks will be conducted by staff, students, and visitors prior to entering a VSCTC facility.
 - Anyone with a temperature above 100 degree should staff home.
 - Anyone exhibiting the following symptoms should stay home. Symptoms include, sore throat, persistent cough, shortness of breath, loss of smell, loss of taste, chills, muscle aches, or headache.

- Physical Distancing
 - Physical distancing will be maintained to the highest degree as possible.

- Cleaning and Hygiene
 - Staff will continue the rigorous sanitizing of labs, classrooms, restrooms, and common areas.
 - Hand sanitizer have been installed outside of every lab/classroom and frequent handwashing will continue to be maintained and encouraged.

- Quarantine requirements for staff and students
 - Quarantine requirements continue to in place per ODH guidelines
 - Staff/Students what test positive for COVID will be quarantined for 10 days
 - Contact tracing will be conducted for any close contacts or exposure to COVID while at school and will be subject to quarantine per ODH guidelines.
 - i. Students who are wearing masks and social distanced will not be subject to quarantine.
 - ii. Vaccinated students will not be subject to quarantine.

- School Events/Visitors
 - There are no current orders limiting travel or event capacity. VSCTC will allow staff/students to travel and participate in school related events while following the outlined safety protocols.
 - Visitors are allowed on campus when related to the educational experience and following the outlined safety protocols
