

Program Overview

What are classes like?

Classes are student-centered and taught by experienced instructors. Classes focus on helping individuals learn at their own pace. Online education and distance programming is also available.

How can I sign up?

Call a center near you to register for the next New Student Orientation. Students are required to attend 3-4 days of orientation before starting classes.

How often should I attend?

Students should attend classes as often as possible. Students must be able to commit to at least 40-60 hours of attendance, or about 2 months of regular classes. Students who meet eligibility criteria may attend Aspire classes as long as necessary to meet educational goals.
