

Program Overview

What are classes like?

Classes are student-centered and taught by experienced instructors. Classes focus on helping individuals set goals, improve skills, learn at their own pace, and achieve success in their education and careers. Online distance learning options are also available to all students.

How can I sign up?

Call a learning center near you to register for the next New Student Orientation. Students are required to attend 3-4 days of orientation before beginning classes.

How often should I attend?

Students should plan to attend classes regularly twice a week. Students must be able to commit to at least 50-60 hours of attendance, or about 2 months of classes. Students who meet eligibility criteria may attend Aspire classes as long as necessary to meet educational goals.
