## Responsibilities:

- Operate high-speed digital can press according to specified criteria and processes.
- Print to proof targets, ensuring consistent accuracy and alignment to match customer specifications.
- Maintain optimal print output to precise quality standards, conducting regular checks to ensure color fidelity and print clarity.
- Complete and maintain documentation as per workflow process, ensuring accurate records are maintained.
- Effectively train print operators to produce 150 million cans that meet customer and company specifications.
- Perform and/or assist with daily preventative maintenance (PM) tasks as required.
- Monitor and maintain ink levels, ensuring sufficient supply to prevent downtime.
- Maintain a clean and organized workspace, adhering to safety and operational standards.
